**ORDER CANCELING PREHEARING CONFERENCE AND**  
**ORDER DIRECTING FILING**

On December 17, 2004, Lula M. Fabyanic filed with the Missouri Public Service Commission a complaint against VarTec Telecom, Inc. Complainant alleged that the company took unreasonable delays in transferring her service to a new residence. She requested that the Commission direct the company to make certain management changes and that she be awarded monetary damages. To move toward a resolution of the complaint, the Commission scheduled a prehearing conference to be held on April 12, 2005.

On April 7, 2005, VarTec filed a letter signed by Complainant agreeing to a settlement amount of \$500.00. Complainant also agreed to withdraw her complaint upon receipt of the check in that amount. Upon receipt of the check, the Commission will require Complainant file a notice, informing the Commission that she has received the check and that she wishes to dismiss her complaint. Also, in light of the settlement, the Commission will cancel the prehearing conference.

**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:**

1. That the prehearing conference scheduled in this matter for April 12, 2005, is canceled.
2. That upon receipt of the settlement amount, Lula M. Fabyanic shall file a notice informing the Commission that she has received the check and wishes that her complaint be dismissed.
3. That this order shall become effective on April 8, 2005.
