ORDER CANCELING PREHEARING CONFERENCE AND ORDER DIRECTING FILING

On December 17, 2004, Lula M. Fabyanic filed with the Missouri Public Service Commission a complaint against VarTec Telecom, Inc. Complainant alleged that the company took unreasonable delays in transferring her service to a new residence. She requested that the Commission direct the company to make certain management changes and that she be awarded monetary damages. To move toward a resolution of the complaint, the Commission scheduled a prehearing conference to be held on April 12, 2005.

On April 7, 2005, VarTec filed a letter signed by Complainant agreeing to a settlement amount of \$500.00. Complainant also agreed to withdraw her complaint upon receipt of the check in that amount. Upon receipt of the check, the Commission will require Complainant file a notice, informing the Commission that she has received the check and that she wishes to dismiss her complaint. Also, in light of the settlement, the Commission will cancel the prehearing conference.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

- 1. That the prehearing conference scheduled in this matter for April 12, 2005, is canceled.
- 2. That upon receipt of the settlement amount, Lula M. Fabyanic shall file a notice informing the Commission that she has received the check and wishes that her complaint be dismissed.
 - 3. That this order shall become effective on April 8, 2005.
