Sprint Communications Company, L.P., has filed an application seeking authority to transfer its Unbundled Network Element Platform (UNE-P) customers to Trinsic Communications, Inc. Sprint also requests that the Commission waive any applicable anti-slamming regulations. Sprint indicates that it expects to complete the transaction by February 1, 2006, and asks the Commission to approve its application by that time.

Before proceeding to consider this application, the Commission would like to have a recommendation from Staff. Therefore, the Commission will direct Staff to file a recommendation by January 4. If Staff finds that it is unable to offer its recommendation by that date, it may, of course, request additional time.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That the Staff of the Commission shall file its recommendation regarding Sprint Communications Company, L.P.'s Application for Approval of Transfer of Customers to Trinsic Communications, Inc., by January 4, 2006.

2. That this order shall become effective on December 15, 2005.
