ORDER DENYING EXPEDITED REVIEW

Issue Date:March 1, 2006Effective Date: March 1, 2006On February 22, 2006, Southwestern Bell Telephone, L.P., d/b/a AT&TMissouri filed a tariff extending the promotional offer for AT&T Missouri'sMetropolitan Calling Area residential customers currently in effect, extending the

promotion from March 7, 2006, through September 7, 2006.

The proposed tariff was rejected by the Missouri Public Service Commission's Electronic Filing and Information System because "promotional tariff filings are not allowed on one-day filings pursuant to Commission discussion in agenda on February 7, 2006."

On February 23, 2006, AT&T Missouri filed an Application for Rehearing and a Motion for Expedited Approval of Tariff asking the Commission to review the rejected tariff and approve the tariff extending the promotional offer for AT&T Missouri's Metropolitan Calling Area residential customers on or before March 1, 2006. AT&T Missouri's request for review of the rejected tariff is denied. As the tariff was rejected, nothing is presently pending before the Commission. If AT&T were to refile the tariff, the matter would be properly before the Commission, to consider whether the tariff was appropriately filed with a one-day effective date.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. The Motion for Expedited Review filed by Southwestern bell Telephone, L.P., d/b/a AT&T Missouri, is denied.

2. This order shall become effective on March 1, 2006.
