NOTICE OF CONTESTED CASE

Issue Date: November 22, 2010

The Commission is giving notice of the commencement of a contested case. On November 19, 2010, the complainant filed the complaint, a copy of which accompanies this notice. Such filing vested the right to a pre-decision evidentiary hearing in the respondent, 1 so that filing instituted a contested case. 2

A contested case is a formal hearing procedure, but the law allows waiver of procedural formalities and a decision without a hearing,3 including by stipulation and

agreement.⁴ Provisions governing discovery are at the Commission's regulation 4 CSR 240-2.090. The Commission's regulations⁵ require the filing of an answer not later than December 22, 2010.

As an alternative to the formal evidentiary hearing procedure, the Commission offers mediation. Mediation is a voluntary process in which a neutral person assists the parties in exploring opportunities for settlement. Upon a request for mediation, the Commission may suspend the filing date set forth in this order.
