ORDERED: 1. That the Joint Motion To Approve Stipulation And Agreement Tariffs To Become Effective On Less Than 30 Days Notice For Good Cause Show hereby granted.

ORDERED: 2. That the tariffs attached to the Stipulation and Agreement s effective for service rendered on or after February 14, 1987.

ORDERED: 3. That St. Joseph Light & Power Company shall not be subject to or future requirements of Case No. AO-87-48 in connection with its operations.
