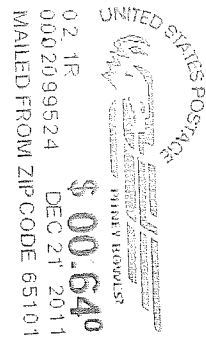
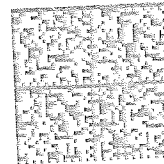

**MOTION TO CANCEL CERTIFICATE OF SERVICE AUTHORITY**

**COMES NOW** the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission (Staff), by and through the undersigned counsel, and moves for the Missouri Public Service Commission (Commission) to cancel the certificate of service authority of Telecor Communications, Inc., (Telecor or Company) and respectfully states as follows:

1. On July 31, 1998, the Commission granted Telecor a certificate of service authority to provide private pay telephone service within the State of Missouri via customer-owned pay telephone (COCT) equipment in Case No. TA-98-558.

2. On February 19, 2004, the Missouri Secretary of State's Office (SOS) revoked the foreign Company's authority to do business in the state of Missouri for failure to file a correct and current 2003 annual report. Pursuant to Section 351.602.3, RSMo (2000), "[t]he authority of a foreign corporation to transact business in this state ceases on the date shown on the certificate revoking its certificate of authority." See Attachment A. The Company never received reinstatement of its authority to transact business in Missouri.

3. On November 18, 2011, Telecor notified the Commission that the Company is no longer doing business in Missouri and has not done so in some time. See Attachment B.

4. Pursuant to 4 CSR 240-3.505(1)(B), COCT providers are exempt from the Section 392.390.1, RSMo (2000) requirement to file annual reports. The Company is delinquent in the payment of its fiscal year 2012 assessment.

5. Because Telecor can no longer lawfully provide telecommunications services in Missouri, and the Company has notified the Staff that it is no longer in operation, the Staff recommends that the Commission cancel the Company's certificate.

6. The Commission has the authority to cancel a telecommunications certificate pursuant to Section 392.410.5, RSMo (Supp. 2010), which provides "[a]ny certificate of service authority may be altered or modified by the commission after notice and hearing, upon its own motion or upon application of the person or company affected."

7. The Commission need not hold a hearing if, after proper notice and opportunity to intervene, no party requests such a hearing. *State ex rel. Rex Deffenderfer Enterprises, Inc. v. Public Service Commission*, 776 S.W. 2d 494 (Mo. App. W.D. 1989).

**WHEREFORE**, the Staff respectfully recommends that the Commission cancel the certificate of service authority of Telecor Communications, Inc., to provide private pay telephone service in the State of Missouri via customer-owned pay telephone (COCT) equipment.
