**ORDER DIRECTING FILING OF STAFF RECOMMENDATION**

On January 10, 2006, the Commission issued its Order Approving Stipulation and Agreement and Order Directing Filings which, among other things, directed Southwestern Bell Telephone, L.P., d/b/a AT&T Missouri, to file tariff sheets designed to implement the provisions of the Stipulation and Agreement with an effective date that is the earliest possible date that the provisions can be implemented. AT&T Missouri withdrew its originally filed tariff sheets and submitted a second set of proposed tariff sheets (Tariff File No. YI-2006-0682) on March 10, 2006, with an effective date of August 22, 2006. On April 25, 2006, the company notified the Commission that it will be able to implement the Stipulation and Agreement earlier than originally anticipated, on June 29, 2006, and would file new tariff sheets reflecting the earlier effective date. AT&T Missouri filed its third set of proposed tariff sheets, Tariff File No. YI-2006-0828, on April 28, 2006. This tariff replaces Tariff File No. YI-2006-0682.

The Commission will set a date for the filing of the Staff's recommendation regarding AT&T Missouri's latest tariff filing. The date previously established for Staff's recommendation is canceled.



**IT IS ORDERED THAT:**

1. Commission Staff shall file its recommendation regarding Tariff File No. YI-2006-0828 of Southwestern Bell Telephone, L.P., d/b/a AT&T Missouri, no later than June 16, 2006.
2. This order shall become effective on May 2, 2006.
