The Commission's Staff; the Office of the Public Counsel; AT&T Missouri; Spectra Communications Group, LLC, d/b/a CenturyTel and CenturyTel of Missouri, LLC; and the Missouri Small Telephone Company Group filed timely responses. Each indicated that additional proceedings would be required to allow for the cross-

examination of U.S. Cellular's witness and for the presentation of additional evidence and argument.

The Commission will schedule a prehearing conference to discuss an appropriate procedural schedule,
