



and stated that AT&T does not object to an extension, contingent on the extension of the tariff effective date. Neutral Tandem also requested that the Commission postpone acting on Staff's request for a prehearing conference.

The Commission has reviewed Staff's response and Neutral Tandem's motion. Since the tariff effective date has been extended to November 20, 2009, the Commission will grant Neutral Tandem's motion to extend its response filing date. The Commission will rule on Staff's request to schedule a prehearing conference at a later date.

**THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:**

1. Neutral Tandem-Missouri, LLC's Second Motion for Extension of Time for Response is granted.
2. Neutral Tandem-Missouri, LLC, shall file its response to AT&T's Motion to Suspend and Investigate Tariff no later than November 9, 2009.
3. Any other responses to AT&T's motion shall be filed no later than November 9, 2009.
4. This order shall become effective upon issuance.
