## ORDER SETTING PREHEARING CONFERENCE

On May 26, 2009, Time Warner Cable Information Services (Missouri), LLC filed a tariff revision, which was extended once, then substituted, then extended three more times after the substitute tariff was filed. The tariff had an effective date of October 9, 2009.

On October 7, in response to a motion filed by its Staff, the Commission suspended the tariff until November 8. In light of the quickly approaching effective date of the tariff, the Commission must expedite these proceedings and will therefore immediately set this matter for a prehearing conference.

This matter is now at issue and a prehearing conference and procedural schedule are appropriate to ensure its prompt resolution. At the prehearing conference, the parties or their representatives should be prepared to discuss the nature of any discovery each will conduct and the interval necessary for its completion; the number of witnesses each expects to call at hearing; the number and nature of any exhibits each expects to offer at hearing; and the anticipated length of the hearing. The parties or their representatives should also be prepared to discuss the current status of settlement negotiations. It is expected that the prehearing conference will provide an opportunity for the parties to further pursue settlement discussions. The Commission will afford the parties an opportunity to participate in this hearing by telephone by calling the number noted below.

## THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

- 1. A prehearing conference shall be held on October 14, 2009, beginning at 10:00 a.m., in Room 305 of the Governor Office Building, 200 Madison Street, Jefferson City, Missouri. This prehearing conference will be held in a building that meets accessibility standards required by the Americans with Disabilities Act.
