**ORDER APPROVING TARIFF  
AND CANCELING PREHEARING CONFERENCE**

On April 19, 2011, the AT&T Companies filed a motion to suspend the tariff filed by Metropolitan Telecommunications of Missouri, Inc. The Commission directed Metropolitan to respond but the company failed to do so. The Commission therefore suspended the tariff for a period of 60 days, until June 24, 2011. The Commission then set this matter for a prehearing conference to be held on May 19.

On May 4, Metropolitan withdrew that portion of its tariff to which AT&T objected. AT&T, therefore, withdrew its motion to suspend the tariff. On May 5, the Staff of the Commission filed a Memorandum recommending that the Commission approve Metropolitan's tariff and cancel the prehearing conference.

This matter became a docketed case upon AT&T's motion. Upon its concerns being satisfied, AT&T has withdrawn its motion. Were it not for AT&T's motion, Metropolitan's tariff would have gone into effect by operation of law on April 25. However, because of the motion, the Commission suspended the tariff for 60 days and must now act to approve it or allow it to go into effect upon the expiration of 60 days. Because there remains no objection to the tariff, the Commission will approve Metropolitan's tariff effective upon

issuance of this order. The Commission will also cancel the prehearing conference set for May 19.

**THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:**

1. Metropolitan Telecommunications of Missouri, Inc.'s tariff, Tariff No. JC-2011-0481 is approved.
2. This order shall become effective upon issuance.
3. This case shall be closed on May 7, 2011.
