PROCEEDINGS

JUDGE WOODRUFF: Welcome everyone. This is a conference that was scheduled in Case No. TT-2006-0113, which concerns the tariffs of CenturyTel of Missouri, and of Spectra Communications Group. We're going to start today by taking entries of appearance, beginning with CenturyTel of Missouri and Spectra.

MR. DORITY: Thank you, your Honor. Let the record reflect the appearance of Larry W. Dority, Fischer and Dority, PC, 101 Madison, Suite 400, Jefferson City, Missouri, 65101, appearing on behalf of CenturyTel of Missouri, LLC, and Spectra Communications Group, LLC, doing business as CenturyTel.

JUDGE WOODRUFF: Thank you, Mr. Dority. And for Socket?

MR. LUMLEY: Good afternoon, your Honor. Carl Lumley, the Curtis Heinz Law Firm, 130 South Bemiston, Suite 200, Clayton, Missouri, 63105.

JUDGE WOODRUFF: Thank you, Mr. Lumley. And for the Staff?

MR. HAAS: William K. Haas appearing on behalf of the Staff of the Public Service Commission. My address is Post Office Box 360, Jefferson City, Missouri.

JUDGE WOODRUFF: Thank you. And for Public Counsel?

1 MR. WHEATLEY: Mark D. Wheatley, Senior Public
2 Counsel, representing the Office of the Counsel and the
3 Public, Post Office Box 2230, Jefferson City, Missouri,
4 65102.

5 JUDGE WOODRUFF: Thank you. And we have
6 several other people on the telephone as well, who are, I
7 believe, not attorneys. Ms. Smith?

8 MS. SMITH: Yes, this is Susan Smith.

9 JUDGE WOODRUFF: All right. Can you tell me
10 who else is on the phone on your end?

11 MS. SMITH: That's it.

12 JUDGE WOODRUFF: That's it. Okay. All right.
13 Well, let's go ahead and get started, then, today, and the
14 reason we scheduled this conference was to give the parties a
15 chance to discuss -- discuss this tariff and how it would be
16 applied to them, and to decide, in fact, whether or not we
17 need to go forward and even have a hearing in this case.

18 I will ask you, of course, to discuss this
19 amongst yourselves, after I -- after we go off the record,
20 and I will ask you to file a proposed procedural schedule by
21 one week from today, which would be October the 18th. Of
22 course, if the parties agree that we don't need to have a
23 hearing, that can be your proposed schedule.

24 Is there any other matter that anyone wants to
25 bring up while we're still on the record?

1 MR. DORITY: I don't think so, Judge, thank
2 you.

3 JUDGE WOODRUFF: Thank you, Mr. DORITY. Then
4 I don't think we need proceed any further with this, and at
5 this time, the on-the-record portion of this conference is
6 adjourned. Thank you.

7 WHEREUPON, the recorded portion of the
8 prehearing conference was concluded.
