The Office of the Secretary of State published, in the *Code of State Regulations*, the Missouri Public Service Commission's Order of Rulemaking for the proposed amendments to the Commission's rules on May 31, 2004. The rules became effective on June 30, 2004.

As required by the Commission's General Procedure 1, Staff investigated "whether the cost to all affected entities exceeded by ten percent or more the estimated cost in the fiscal note or, where appropriate, has exceeded five hundred dollars." Staff concluded that the costs have not exceeded ten percent or five hundred dollars. On July 20, 2005, Staff filed a memorandum in accordance with the Commission's General Procedure.
