2	JUDGE DIPPELL: This is September 1st, 2021 in
3	File Number WE-2021-0390 in the Matter of the Joint Application
4	of Missouri-American Water Company and DCM Land, LLC for a
5	Variance from the Company's Tariff Provisions Regarding the
6	Extension of Company Mains. My name is Nancy Dippell and I'm
7	the regulatory law judge assigned to this matter. We've come
8	here today for a procedural conference in this case which is a
9	little unusual or a little out of the every day. I wanted to
10	get you all together so that we could come up with a procedure
11	for going forward.
12	In this I know that Company had requested a

21	Missouri-American side.
22	JUDGE DIPPELL: Okay. Ms. Schultz, anything?
23	MS. SCHULTZ: DCM Land does have an interest in
24	the proceeding being handled as expeditiously as possible since
25	it is an ongoing development. I think though I am not as

ASLIN: We haven't planned to file anything 8 else at this time. We were going to see where things were going 9 procedurally. 10 JUDGE DIPPELL: It sounds like what needs to 11 happen is -- and I set a short date for you all to file a 12 procedural schedule. So if you haven't had a chance to come 13 together to talk about that, then maybe I just need to bow out here and let you all talk on this conference call. Would that 14 15 be what you all would want to do then? It sounds like there's nothing further for me to do at this point. I really just kind 16 17 of need you all to suggest a procedure going forward. Okay. 18 MS. SCHULTZ: I think that would be a fair 19 approach. 20 MR. COOPER: Yeah. I think that makes sense. 21 JUDGE DIPPELL: Okay. The question is, can I 22 bow out. Ms. Aslin, you are on the phone so I can hand over the 23 hostess to you. I am not sure I can't over hostess to you. I 24 am not sure that I can make someone a host that is outside the PSC, but what I will do is I will figure out how to get off of 25
