## WITHDRAWAL OF MOTION TO COMPEL

Kansas City Power & Light Company ("KCPL") hereby withdraws without prejudice its motion to compel Trigen-Kansas City Energy Corporation ("Trigen") to provide the workpapers associated with its pre-filed testimony in this case. In support thereof, KCPL states as follows:

- 1. On May 9, 2008, KCPL requested that the Commission compel Trigen to provide the workpapers associated with its pre-filed testimony in this case. In an order issued May 19, 2008, the Commission directed KCPL to withdraw its motion if there was no formal data request pending and no need for a discovery conference.
- 2. On May 23, 2008, KCPL issued formal data requests to Trigen requesting the workpapers of its witnesses. Because the deadline for providing responses to those data requests has not yet occurred, KCPL does not yet know whether a discovery dispute will arise. Consequently, KCPL withdraws its motion to compel, but reserves the right to renew its motion if Trigen does not adequately respond to the data requests described herein.
