ORDER DENYING MOTION TO INTERVENE

On April 12, 1995, TCG America, Inc. (TCG) filed a Motion To Intervene out of time in this proceeding. TCG states that it is seeking intervention at this time because of the Commission indication in its order issued March 31, 1995, that the 314 renumbering plan might affect the provision of Local Plus service, which is the subject of this case. TCG states that it has intervened in Case No. TO-95-289, et al., the 314 renumbering case, and that it has a similar interest in this case which is different from that of the general public.

On April 17, 1995, Southwestern Bell Telephone Company (SWB) filed a response to TCG's motion opposing the intervention of TCG. SWB states that TCG should have known the potential effect of the 314 renumbering issue on this case because of SWB's initial filing as well as the pleadings of other interexchange carriers. SWB states that TCG's expertise is better suited for Case No. TO-95-289, et al., that its interest in this case is no different from that of the general public.

The Commission finds that the Motion To Intervene of TCG should be denied. TCG's interest in this proceeding appears to be tied to 314 renumbering and TCG has been granted intervention in that case. The Commission decision in TO-95-289, et al., will be issued prior to the hearings in this case and there-

fore any renumbering issue will be resolved. Since that issue will be resolved prior to hearings in this case, the Commission finds TCG's interest will no longer be other than the general public's.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That TCG America, Inc.'s Motion To Intervene is hereby denied.
2. That this order shall become effective on the date hereof.
