- 4 JUDGE DALE: Good morning. We are here in
- 5 the matter of the Staff vs. the Missouri Public Service --
- 6 the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission,
- 7 Complainant vs. Suburban Water and Sewer, Inc. and Gordon
- 8 Burnam, Respondents, Case No. WC-2008-0030.
- 9 It is July 8th, 2008, and I am Colleen
- 10 Dale. I have taken over this case from Judge Lane. And
- 11 we will begin with entries of appearance. Staff?
- 12 MS. BRUEGGEMANN: For Staff, Steve Reed and
- 13 Shelley Brueggemann, located at 200 Madison Street,
- 14 P.O. Box 360, Jefferson City, 65102.
- MS. BAKER: Christina Baker for the Office
