2	JUDGE JORDAN: The Commission is calling
3	the case in File No. WC-2016-0079. This is the small
4	formal complaint of Rhonda Martin versus Missouri-
5	American Water Company. We're here for a pre-hearing
6	conference.
7	My name is Daniel Jordan. I'm a
8	Regulatory Law Judge assigned to this action, and we
9	will begin with entries of appearance, and I'll ask
10	counsel and Ms. Martin to introduce any anyone who
11	is not counsel with them, also.
12	Let's start with the complainant, Ms.
13	Martin?
14	MS. MARTIN: Yeah.
15	JUDGE JORDAN: I'm going to turn you up
16	here a little bit.
17	And you're that's Ms. Martin, Ms.
18	Rhonda Martin, the complainant?
19	MS. MARTIN: Yeah.
20	JUDGE JORDAN: And you have someone
21	accompanying you as well?
22	MS. MARTIN: Yeah.
23	JUDGE JORDAN: And will you introduce
24	hi m?
25	MS. MARTIN: His name is Dan Hyatt. He

1	is my landlord.					
2	JUDGE JORDAN: The Landlord, did you say?					
3	MS. MARTIN: Yes.					
4	JUDGE JORDAN: Yes. You're kind of					
5	fading in and out again, so I'm going to turn you up a					
6	little bit here.					
7	MS. MARTIN: Okay.					
8	JUDGE JORDAN: All right.					
9	And, now, Missouri-American Water					
10	Company.					
11	MR. LUFT: This is Tim Luft, Missouri-					
12	American Water Company, 1127 Craig Road, St. Louis					
13	Missouri, 63141. I am the attorney for the company.					
14	MR. COOPER: This is Dean Cooper from the					
15	law firm of Brydon, Swearengen & England appearing for					
16	the Missouri-American Water Company. The Court					
17	Reporter has the address.					
18	MR. JOHNSON: This is Mark Johnson on					
19	behalf of Staff.					
20	MR. THOMPSON: P.O. Box 360, Jefferson					
21	City, Missouri, 65102, and accompanying us is Ms. Gay					
22	Fred who is the head of the Staff Consumer Services					
23	Uni t.					
24	JUDGE JORDAN: Thank you.					
25	And Chief Staff Counsel; is that correct?					

1	MR. THOMPSON: Chief Staff Counsel,
2	that's correct.
3	JUDGE JORDAN: Anyone here from the
4	Office of Public Counsel?
5	(No response.)
6	JUDGE JORDAN: Not hearing anyone not
7	seeing anyone in the room and not hearing anyone on the
8	line, the Office of Public Counsel is a party to this
9	action by regulation but has elected to make no
10	appearance so far it seems.
11	Well, here's what we're going to do
12	today. We're going to have this pre-hearing conference
13	in part on the record. We have a Court Reporter
14	recording this portion. We can discuss procedure, we
15	can discuss substantive issues if the parties want, and
16	we can certainly explore the possibilities for
17	settlement.
18	After we've done that, we will go off the
19	record, and I will leave the room, and the reason we
20	we do that and make this this space and time
21	available is so that the parties can discuss issues
22	that may be sensitive that they maybe don't want the
23	Regulatory Law Judge to hear, so they can speak frankly
24	and candidly without prejudicing their case. And, I'll

also remind the parties that mediation is also possible

1	if they have if they would like to have some help
2	working things out.
3	We have this line open for one hour, and
4	when the parties are through with this, I'll ask Staff
5	to turn off the phone and let me know. I'll be in my
6	office all day, as far as I know.
7	There is one thing I want to mention a
8	couple things I want to mention in case this case does
9	go to hearing, and that is it will be a formal
10	evidentiary hearing. It's a lot like a Circuit Court
11	action without a jury. I'm going to make sure that
12	everyone is aware of the statute which governs
13	admissible evidence that is in the Revised Statutes of
14	Missouri, Section 536.070. That's 536.070.
15	And, when the time comes, if it does come
16	for an evidentiary hearing, please remember that I'm
17	just an administrative lawyer, I'm not an engineer, I'm
18	not an accountant, so make sure that you present your
19	case in words of one syllable, if if we come to a
20	heari ng.
21	Questions so far?
22	MS. MARTIN: I'm not at this time.
23	JUDGE JORDAN: Thank you, Ms. Martin.
24	Anything from the utility?
25	MR COOPER. No your Honor

1	JUDGE JORDAN: And from Staff?			
2	MR. THOMPSON: No, Judge. I guess, if			
3	there's a hearing, it will be held in St. Louis.			
4	JUDGE JORDAN: According to regulation on			
5	small formal complaints, yes.			
6	MR. THOMPSON: Okay. Thank you.			
7	JUDGE JORDAN: Anything else that I can			
8	do for the parties while I'm here and we are on the			
9	record?			
10	MS. MARTIN: No. Thank you.			
11	JUDGE JORDAN: Okay.			
12	Well, with that, then, I will adjourn			
13	this on-the-record portion of the pre-hearing			
14	conference, and we will go off the record.			
15	Thank you. Thank you, everyone.
