ORDER GRANTING MOTIONS TO FILE OUT OF TIME

On September 19, 2005, the Commission issued an order directing various parties to expeditiously file supplemental pleadings. On September 20, the Commission's Staff filed its response, along with a motion for leave to file out of time. Although Staff filed its pleading on September 20, it missed the 3:00 p.m. deadline "despite its best efforts."

On September 21, Southwestern Bell Telephone, L.P., d/b/a SBC Missouri, filed its response to the Commission's September 19 Order. SBC Missouri also filed a motion requesting that the Commission accept SBC Missouri's filing past the 12:00 p.m. deadline. SBC Missouri indicates that despite its best efforts, the company was not able to meet the 12:00 p.m. deadline, in part because not all filings required by the Commission's September 19 order were made by the 3:00 p.m. deadline on September 20.

The Commission has reviewed the motions requesting leave to file out of time and finds that they are reasonable and should be granted. The Commission appreciates the parties efforts in filing the pleadings upon such short notice.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That Staff's Motion for Leave to File Out of Time, filed September 20, 2005, is granted.
2. That the Motion to Accept Filing Past the Commission's 12:00 p.m. Deadline, filed by Southwestern Bell Telephone, L.P., d/b/a SBC Missouri, on September 21, 2005, is granted.
3. That this order shall become effective on September 26, 2005.
