On August 8, 2006, the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission filed a report pursuant to Section 392.245.5, RSMo, regarding conditions for competitive classification for Southwestern Bell Telephone, L.P., d/b/a AT&T Missouri's competitively classified exchanges. Because AT&T Missouri is a necessary party for a full adjudication of this matter, the Commission will add AT&T Missouri as a party to this case.

In addition, the Commission will issue notice and set a date for other interested parties to file requests to intervene. If no hearing is requested, the Commission may make its determination based on the verified pleadings and recommendations.¹

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. Southwestern Bell Telephone, L.P., d/b/a AT&T Missouri, is added as a party to this case.
2. The Data Center of the Missouri Public Service Commission shall send notice of this application to all parties to Commission Case Nos. TO-2006-0093 and TO-2006-0102, to all certificated competitive local exchange carriers, and to all incumbent local exchange carriers in the state of Missouri.

3. The Public Information Office of the Missouri Public Service Commission shall provide notice of the application to the members of the General Assembly and to the news media.
