ORDER GRANTING INTERVENTION

On March 8, 2007, the Commission issued an order setting an intervention deadline of March 22, 2007. AT&T Missouri filed a timely application to intervene.

Commission rule 4 CSR 240-2.075 governs intervention before the Commission. That rule states that the Commission may allow a party to intervene if the proposed intervenor has an interest which is different from that of the general public and which may be adversely affected by a final order arising from the case, or granting the proposed intervention would serve the public interest. Upon review of the application, and considering no objections have been made to AT&T Missouri's Application to Intervene, the Commission finds that the proposed intervenor either has an interest which is different from that of the general public and which may be adversely affected by a final order arising from the case, or that granting the proposed intervention would serve the public interest. Therefore, the Commission will grant AT&T Missouri's application to intervene.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. The application to intervene filed by AT&T Missouri, is granted.
2. This order shall become effective on March 26, 2007.
