ORDER GRANTING APPLICATIONS TO INTERVENE

On March 2, 2007, the Missouri Public Service Commission issued an order directing that notice be issued of an application, filed by the United Way of Greater St. Louis, Inc., as captioned above. The order also required that applications to intervene be filed no later than March 22, 2007.

The Missouri Independent Telephone Company Group,¹ AT&T Missouri, Windstream Missouri, Inc., and CenturyTel of Missouri, LLC and Spectra Communications Group, LLC d/b/a CenturyTel all filed timely applications to intervene. All applicants point out that they have interests which are different from those of the general public and either those interests may be adversely affected or granting intervention would serve the public interest.

Commission rule 4 CSR 240-2.080(15) requires that responsive pleadings be filed within ten days. No opposition to the applications to intervene has been filed. The

Commission has reviewed the applications and finding that they comply with Commission rule concerning interventions², will grant the requested relief.

1. The applications to intervene in this matter filed by Missouri Independent Telephone Company Group, AT&T Missouri, Windstream Missouri, Inc., and CenturyTel of Missouri, LLC and Spectra Communications Group, LLC d/b/a CenturyTel are granted.

2. This order shall become effective on April 17, 2007.
