### ORDER REJECTING TARIFF FILING

On January 12, 2012, the Staff of the Commission filed a motion asking the Commission to reject a tariff filing made on January 9 by Matrix Telecom, Inc. Staff does not take issue with the substance of Matrix Telecom's tariff. Rather, Staff is concerned that Matrix Telecom purports to submit a revised access services tariff under the doing business name of Trinsic Communications to replace an existing tariff under the doing business name of Matrix Business Technologies. Unfortunately, Matrix Telecom is not authorized to do business in Missouri under the name Trinsic Communications and the Commission has not recognized Matrix Telecom's use of that name. For that reason, the Commission will reject Matrix Telecom's tariff filing. Matrix Telecom is free to refile its proposed tariff revision under its proper name. Or, if it wishes to change the name by which it does business in Missouri, it may take the steps described in Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.062 to inform the Commission of that name change.

#### THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

- 1. The tariff submitted under Tariff No. JC-2012-0326 on January 9, 2012, by Matrix Telecom, Inc. d/b/a Trinsic Communications is rejected.
