## **NOTICE OF FINDING**

Pursuant to Section 536.016, RSMo 2000,<sup>1</sup> a state agency is required to find that a proposed rule is necessary to carry out the purposes of the statute that granted the rulemaking authority. Based on the presentation at the Commission's Agenda session held on September 23, 2003, and subsequent discussions on that day and on September 25, the Commission made a finding that emergency rules establishing the parameters of per-line blocking are necessary to carry out the purposes of Section 386.210 *et seq.* and Section 392.010 *et seq.*, RSMo 2000.
