ORDER GRANTING LEAVE TO AMEND APPLICATION

The Missouri Public Service Commission is granting MAWC's Motion for Leave to Amend Application ("motion") that Missouri-American Water Company ("MAWC") filed on November 30, 2009. MAWC's application seeks a variance from the Commission's regulations on termination of service and includes an illustrative tariff sheet as an exhibit. That exhibit is the subject of the motion, by which MAWC offers a different illustrative tariff sheet.

To do so, MAWC must have the Commission's leave to amend its application because the ten day window for amendment as a matter of right has expired under the Commission's regulation on amendments:

> Any pleading [1] may be amended within ten (10) days of filing, unless a responsive pleading has already been filed, or at any time by leave of the commission.[2]

That regulation offers no standard by which to decide the motion. Nonetheless, the motion describes good cause to grant it, meaning reasonableness and good faith.³ MAWC states that the amendment will better illustrate the variance it seeks.
