## ORDER GRANTING EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE ANNUAL REPORTS

On April 6, 2010, Ozark Shores Water Company filed an application asking the Commission to extend the time within which it is required to file its 2009 annual report from April 15, 2010, to July 31, 2010. On April 13, the Commission's Staff filed a recommendation indicating its support for an extension until July 31, 2010.

Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-3.640 requires all water utilities to submit an annual report to the Commission on or before April 15 of each year. However, that rule allows a company to request an extension of greater than thirty days by filing a pleading before April 15, stating the reason for and the length of the requested extension.

Ozark's pleading meets the requirements of the rules and the relief the company requests is reasonable. Therefore, the Commission will extend the time within which Ozark shall file its 2009 annual reports to July 31, 2010.

## THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

- 1. The time within which Ozark Shores Water Company, shall file its 2009 annual reports is extended to July 31, 2010.
  - 2. This order shall become effective on April 14, 2010.

3. This case shall be closed on April 15, 2010.
