ORDER SETTING PREHEARING CONFERENCE

The complaint and response have been filed in this case. Thereafter, the Commission directed its staff to act as a neutral third party and conduct an impartial investigation followed by a report of its findings. Staff's report was filed on November 29, 2001. The complainant filed a response to staff report on January 22, 2002, and no further action has been taken on this case. Therefore, it is appropriate to set this case for prehearing in order to determine the current posture of this matter and to establish a procedural schedule if necessary.

As with all prehearings, the parties are ordered to appear on the day of the prehearing with their subject matter experts and witnesses for negotiation purposes. At the prehearing conference, the parties should be prepared to state with specificity their position on both fact and legal issues in this case. In addition, the parties should be prepared to identify what issues would be presented if this case were to go to hearing and how many witnesses would be necessary to support those issues.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That the parties shall appear as set out herein for a prehearing conference at 10:00 a.m. on March 12, 2002. The prehearing conference will be held in hearing room 305 at the Commission's offices in the Governor Office Building, 200 Madison Street, Jefferson City, Missouri. This hearing will be held in a building that meets accessibility standards required by the Americans with Disabilities Act. 2. That this order shall become effective on February 25, 2002.


