ORDER DIRECTING SUPPLEMENTAL NOTICE AND SETTING HEARING ON STIPULATION

The parties filed a Stipulation and Agreement on May 20, 1997, purporting to resolve the issues in this case. Because of the nature of the service Local Line intends to provide, the parties agreed to certain waivers in addition to those previously approved for competitive local exchange carriers. Not all the waivers Local Line is now requesting, and the parties have agreed to, were listed in the company's initial application and the Order and Notice. The parties requested the Commission to issue a supplemental notice to interested parties to alert them to the fact that additional waivers could be granted.

The Commission finds that additional notice should be given to the same companies that receive notice of applications for interexchange service authority to advise them that Local Line is requesting all the waivers listed below:

Applications to intervene should be submitted by June 12, 1997, to the Executive Secretary of the Missouri Public Service Commission, Post Office Box 360, Jefferson City, Missouri 65102, and copies sent to counsel for Local Line and for the intervenors.

The Commission also finds that this case presents new issues and a hearing is necessary for the Commission to determine whether the stipulation should be approved. Accordingly, the Commission will schedule a stipulation presentation hearing.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

- 1. That the Records Department of the Commission shall send notice of this application as described above.
- 2. That parties wishing to intervene shall file an application to intervene no later than June 12, 1997.
- 3. That the Commission shall conduct a hearing to determine whether the Stipulation and Agreement should be approved on June 30, 1997, at 10:00 a.m. in the Commission's hearing room on the fifth floor of the Harry S Truman State Office Building, 301 West High Street, Jefferson City, Missouri.
- 4. That anyone wishing to attend the hearing who has special needs as addressed by the Americans With Disabilities Act should contact the Missouri Public Service Commission at least ten (10) days before the
