ORDER APPROVING INTEREXCHANGE CERTIFICATE OF SERVICE AUTHORITY AND ORDER APPROVING TARIFF

BellSouth Long Distance, Inc. (BSLD or Applicant) applied to the Public Service Commission on April 25, 1997, for a certificate of service authority to provide intrastate interexchange telecommunications services in Missouri under § 392.440 RSMo 1994[†]. BSLD asked the Commission to classify it as a competitive company and waive certain statutes and rules as authorized by §§ 392.361 and 392.420. Applicant is a Delaware corporation, with its principal office located at 32 Perimeter Center East, Atlanta, Georgia 30346.

The Commission issued a Notice of Applications and Opportunity to Intervene on May 13 directing parties wishing to intervene in the case to file their requests by May 28. Since no one requested a hearing or permission to intervene, the Commission determines that no hearing is necessary. State ex rel. Rex Deffenderfer Enterprises, Inc. v. Public Service Commission, 776 S.W.2d 494, 496 (Mo. App. 1989).
