ORDER STAYING PROCEEDINGS

The Commission received a petition on July 23, 1997, requesting Community Optional Service (COS) from the Belgrade exchange served by GTE Midwest Incorporated (GTE) to GTE's Potosi exchange.

Because intraLATA dialing parity has been mandated by the Federal Telecommunications Act of 1996, all Missouri COS issues are currently under review. The Commission must consider how intraLATA dialing parity and the development of a competitive intraLATA toll market will affect COS service, and whether continued provision of COS will require changes in the service. These issues are being considered in Case No. TW-97-333. Therefore, the Commission will not direct the preparation of calling studies in this case and will stay any further proceedings pending the outcome of TW-97-333.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That all proceedings in this case are stayed pending the outcome of Case No. TW-97-333.

2. That this order shall become effective on the date hereof.
