ORDER GRANTING EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE REPORT

On November 2, 1994, the Office of the Public Counsel (OPC) filed a Motion For Extension Of Time (Motion). OPC states that its Report on Kansas City Power & Light Company's Integrated Resource Planning filing was due on November 2, 1994. OPC further states that due to complications with different word processing systems, OPC was unable to submit the Report by the due date, but instead submitted it on November 3, 1994. OPC states that the minimal delay will not harm any other parties in this proceeding.
