ORDER APPROVING NEELYVILLE DISTRICT RATES EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1, 1995

On November 30, 1994, United Cities Gas Company (Company) of Brentwood, Tennessee, filed with this Commission for approval, a tariff sheet which reflects a net increase in the Purchased Gas Adjustment (PGA) factors for its Neelyville District resulting from an increase in spot market gas costs, the initiation of a new refund factor, and an increase in its Actual Cost Adjustment (ACA) factor. Additionally, the Avoided Commodity Cost for Transportation Customers will increase.

Case No. GR-94-63, under which this change was filed, was established to address Company's PGA factors that are contained in its 1993-1994 ACA filing.

The Missouri Public Service Commission Staff (Staff) has reviewed the filing and is of the opinion that the proposed changes were calculated in compliance with the current PGA Clause and recommends that the proposed tariff sheet be approved. Also, Staff requested permission to submit its evaluation and recommendation of the data contained in this ACA filing, on or before October 1, 1995.

After reviewing Staff's recommendation and request, the Commission is of the opinion that the proposed tariff sheet should be allowed to become effective on and after the requested effective date of January 1, 1995.

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IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That the following tariff sheet filed November 30, 1994 by United Cities Gas Company of Brentwood, Tennessee, for the purpose of reflecting a net increase in the PGA factors as a result of an increase in its spot market gas

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costs, the initiation of a new refund factor, and an increase in its ACA factor, be, and the same is, hereby authorized to become effective on and after January 1, 1995.

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2. That the Commission's Procurement Analysis Department be given the time necessary to conduct its audit of this ACA period and submit its results and recommendations regarding this ACA on or before October 1, 1995.

3. That this order shall become effective on January 1, 1995.
