Atmos Energy Corporation herewith submits for filing the 3rd Revised Sheet No. 44 for all areas of Missouri which replaces the 2nd Revised Sheet No. 44.

This filing reflects an increase in rates for all the areas of Missouri. As a result of this filing a typical residential customer in the West Area (Old Butler) will experience an increase of approximately 31%; in the West Area (Old Greeley) an increase of approximately 22%, in the Southeastern Area (Old SEMO) an increase of approximately 27%; in the Southeastern Area (Old Neelyville) an increase of approximately 30%, in the Kirksville Area an increase of approximately 31%, and in the Northeastern Area approximately an increase of 29% during this summer season.
