COMES NOW Western Communications, Inc. ("Western") pursuant to Rule 4 CSR 240-2.085 and hereby moves the Commission to issue a standard protective order on the following grounds:

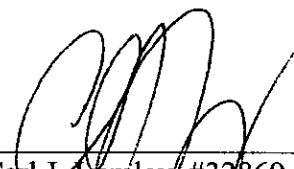
1. Western has herewith filed its Application for Approval of the Transfer of Assets and Subscribers of Logix Communications Corp. and for Waiver of Commission Rule 33.150.

2. The Commission has recognized in numerous dockets that there is a genuine need to protect certain confidential information from disclosure. The issuance of protective orders in prior cases has led to the development of a smoother and more orderly discovery procedure, has helped to minimize disputes, and has provided a sound method for submitting confidential information.

3. In this case, certain financial information regarding the company is competitively sensitive and should be protected against public disclosure. None of the information for which a claim of confidentiality is made can be found in any format in any public document.

4. The Commission should establish its standard protective order.

WHEREFORE, Western Communications respectfully requests the Commission
to issue a protective order.
