ORDER GRANTING REQUEST FOR MODIFICATION
OR CLARIFICATION

On March 27, 1995, Ahlstrom Development Corporation and Cottonwood Energy Partners, L.P. (Ahlstrom) filed a Request For Clarification Or Modification of the Commission's March 15, 1995 order. Ahlstrom requests that the Commission clarify or modify its March 15, 1995 order to allow Complainants access to Highly Confidential (H/C) materials where (1) the individual employee had originated the H/C material; (2) the H/C material indicated that the individual employee had been involved in a specific meeting or teleconference; or (3) the H/C material indicated that certain statements had been made by the individual employee.

The Commission will grant Ahlstrom's request so long as the employees are officers or management level employees. To ensure clarity of the record, the Commission will order Ahlstrom to provide the names and titles of the employees for which access to certain H/C material is requested.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:


1. That the Request For Clarification Or Modification filed by Ahlstrom Development Corporation and Cottonwood Energy Partners, L.P., on

March 27, 1995, be, and is hereby, granted so long as the employees for which access to certain Highly Confidential information is sought are officers or management level employees.

2. That Ahlstrom Development Corporation and Cottonwood Energy Partners, L.P. shall file, no later than April 17, 1995, a list of the names and positions of the individual employees for which access to certain Highly Confidential information is sought.

3. That this order shall become effective on the date hereof.
