ORDER DIRECTING FILING

On April 18, 2007, The Raytown Water Company (“RWC”), by and through its attorney, filed an application requesting that the Missouri Public Service Commission extend the time within which it may file its 2006 annual report respecting its regulated water operations to June 15, 2007.¹

Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-3.640(7) states:

A water utility that is unable to meet the submission date established in section (1) of this rule may request an extension of greater than thirty (30) days for submitting its annual report by:

- (A) Filing a pleading, in compliance with the requirements of Chapter 2 of 4 CSR 240, which states the reason for and the length of the extension being requested, with the commission prior to April 15; and
- (B) Certifying that a copy of the pleading was sent to all parties of record in pending cases before the commission where the utility’s activities are the primary focus of the proceedings.

Although RWC’s April 20, 2007 application meets all of these requirements, the Commission would be aided by a recommendation from its Staff as to whether the

extension should be granted and under what conditions, if any. Therefore, the Commission will order Staff to file a recommendation in this case by no later than May 1, 2007.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. Staff shall prepare and file, by no later than May 1, 2007, a recommendation regarding The Raytown Water Company's April 20, 2007 application to extend the time within which it may file its 2006 annual report respecting its regulated water operations to June 15, 2007.

2. This order shall become effective on April 24, 2007.
