

In the Matter of a Request for the Modification of the  
Kansas City Metropolitan Calling Area Plan to Make  
the Greenwood Exchange Part of the Mandatory MCA  
Tier 2.

On March 10, 2005, the Commission issued an order setting an intervention deadline of March 30, 2005. Applications to intervene were filed by MoKan Dial, Inc.;<sup>1</sup> Cass County Telephone Company and Lathrop Telephone Company; and CenturyTel of Missouri, LLC, and Spectra Communications Group, LLC, d/b/a CenturyTel. The Commission has reviewed these applications to intervene and finds that they substantially comply with the Commission's rules regarding intervention. The Commission finds that the potential intervenors have interests in this matter that are different from those of the general public, and that granting intervention would serve the public interest. The Commission concludes that it should grant the requests for intervention.

1. That the application to intervene filed by MoKan Dial, Inc., is granted.
2. That the application to intervene filed by Cass County Telephone Company and Lathrop Telephone Company is granted.

3. That the application to intervene filed by CenturyTel of Missouri, LLC, and Spectra Communications Group, LLC, d/b/a CenturyTel, is granted.

4. That this order shall become effective on April 12, 2005.
