On October 11, 2010, National Water and Power, Inc. ("NWP") filed a response objecting to the Commission's Staff's motion for leave to amend its complaint. The Commission will set a deadline for Staff to reply.

Also in its response, NWP asserts the key issue in this case is whether Respondents meet the legal definition of water or sewer utilities subject to the jurisdiction of this Commission. NWP indicates it is preparing a motion on this issue. Because the jurisdictional issue could be dispositive of this matter the Commission will direct expeditious briefing on this issue.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission shall reply to National Water and Power, Inc.'s October 11, 2010 pleading no later than October 22, 2010.

2. National Water and Power, Inc. shall file its motion challenging the Commission's

jurisdiction (fully briefing the issue) and any supporting evidence no later than November 1, 2010.

3. The Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission shall respond to National Water and Power, Inc.'s motion challenging the Commission's jurisdiction (fully briefing the issue), and any supporting evidence it may have, no later than November 22, 2010.

4. This order shall become effective immediately upon issuance.
