- 3 please.
- 4 Good morning. We are here for the prehearing
- 5 conference set in Case No. TT-2004-0120, In the Matter
- 6 of the Application of Southwestern Bell Telephone
- 7 Company, doing business as SBC Filing Tariff Revisions
- 8 to Suspend Billing and Collection Services for a
- 9 Customer if the Customer is in Breach of Any Other
- 10 Agreement between the Parties.
- I am Ron Pridgin, the Regulatory Law Judge
- 12 assigned to this case. This prehearing conference is
- being held on November 12th, 2003 at ten o'clock in the
- 14 morning at the Hotel Governor Office Building in
- 15 Jefferson City, Missouri.
- We are here because of the Commission's
- 17 October 28th, 2003 order, that order suspending tariffs
- 18 and scheduling a prehearing conference in this case.
- 19 If I could, at this time I would like to get
- 20 entries of appearance from counsel, beginning with
- 21 Staff, please?
- MR. HAAS: Good morning. William K. Haas
- 23 appears for the Staff of the Public Service Commission.

- 25 Missouri.

- JUDGE PRIDGIN: Mr. Haas, thank you.
- 2 Anyone here on behalf of the Office of the
- 3 Public Counsel?
- 4 (No response.)
- 5 JUDGE PRIDGIN: Seeing none, on behalf of SBC,
- 6 please?
- 7 MR. BUB: Thank you, Your Honor.
- 8 Leo Bub for SBC, Missouri. Our address is
- 9 One SBC Center, St. Louis, Missouri 63101.
- 10 JUDGE PRIDGIN: Mr. Bub, thank you.
- On behalf of AT&T, please?
- MR. COMLEY: Good morning, Judge. Let the
- 13 record reflect the entry of appearance of Mark W.
- 14 Comley, Newman, Comley & Ruth, 601 Monroe Street,
- 15 Jefferson City, Missouri, on behalf of AT&T
- 16 Communications of the Southwest.
- JUDGE PRIDGIN: Mr. Comley, thank you.
- 18 Now on behalf of MCI Worldcom Communications,
- 19 please?
- 20 MR. LUMLEY: Good morning, Your Honor. Carl
- 21 Lumley of the Curtis, Oetting Law Firm, 130 South
- 22 Bemiston, Suite 200, Clayton, Missouri 63105.
- JUDGE PRIDGIN: Mr. Lumley, thank you.
- On behalf of Sprint -- is it -- I'm sorry. Is
- 25 it Sprint Missouri?

- 1 MR. GARDNER: Yes.
- 2 Paul H. Gardner, appearing on behalf of Sprint
- 3 Missouri, Goller, Gardner and Feather, 131 East High
- 4 Street, Jefferson City, Missouri.
- 5 JUDGE PRIDGIN: Mr. Gardner, thank you.
- Any parties I have neglected to mention?
- 7 (No response.)
- 8 JUDGE PRIDGIN: All right. Seeing none, let
- 9 me ask the parties if there's anything they need to
- 10 bring to my attention. I -- I don't think I have any
- 11 pending motions out there.
- 12 MR. COMLEY: Let me bring this to the Court's
- 13 attention.
- JUDGE PRIDGIN: Mr. Comley?
- MR. COMLEY: I've noticed that the motion
- 16 filed by AT&T was a motion to suspend the tariffs, and
- 17 it was not joined with an application to intervene.
- 18 I was going to ask the indulgence of the
- 19 parties if the Commission would grant me leave to
- 20 orally request intervention for the company at this
- 21 time and see if there was any objections to that.
- 22 JUDGE PRIDGIN: All right.
- MR. BUB: We don't object, Your Honor.
- JUDGE PRIDGIN: All right. I see a -- a bunch
- 25 of heads shaking no. Mr. Comley, I'll -- I'll take

- 1 your oral motion to intervene, and we'll grant that.
- 2 And I will follow that up with a written order.
- 3 MR. COMLEY: Okay. Thank you very much.
- 4 JUDGE PRIDGIN: You're welcome.
- 5 Anything else?
- 6 (No response.)
- JUDGE PRIDGIN: All right. I -- I assume,
- 8 Mr. Bub, because SBC extended the tariff dates, I don't
- 9 know, two or three times perhaps, that the reason you
- 10 were doing this is that you were negotiating with the
- 11 parties; is that correct?
- 12 MR. BUB: Yes, Your Honor. And -- and we
- 13 continue to do that.
- 14 JUDGE PRIDGIN: All right.
- MR. BUB: And we expect after we go off the
- 16 record, we'll have some further discussions, you know,
- 17 face to face. We've pretty much been doing it by email
- 18 and telephone conference --
- 19 JUDGE PRIDGIN: Certainly.
- 20 MR. BUB: -- so we look to have some
- 21 productive discussions this morning.
- 22 JUDGE PRIDGIN: All right. So I assume this
- 23 is really the first time you've really been able to sit
- 24 down with everybody in the same room and --
- MR. BUB: Face to face, yes.

- 1 JUDGE PRIDGIN: Right. Okay. Great.
- I will remind the parties that I've ordered a
- 3 proposed procedural schedule to be filed by
- 4 November 19th, and that I've -- we've got a calendar up
- 5 on the 9th floor if the parties need to come check
- 6 dates as far as when -- when the Commission would be
- 7 available for the hearing.
- 8 I will remind the parties that I don't know
- 9 what your time frame is, but when you go upstairs,
- 10 you'll probably notice the calendar is pretty full for
- 11 quite a while. We've got a lot of rate cases that
- 12 we're juggling right now, and would -- would ask the
- 13 parties to try to keep in mind that -- that even though
- 14 a date may be physically open, that because of
- 15 business, that being local public hearings and -- and
- 16 rate cases, that just because the date's open doesn't
- 17 necessarily mean you're going to get a -- a -- as
- 18 prompt a resolution of the case as you might otherwise.
- 19 Again, just because we have so many rate cases going on
- 20 right now.
- 21 Anything else that the parties wish to bring
- 22 to my attention?
- 23 (No response.)
- JUDGE PRIDGIN: All right. Seeing nothing,
- 25 again, I'm up on the 9th floor if anybody needs me.
