On July 26, 2013, the Commission issued a notice informing interested stakeholders that the Commission's Staff would collect comments about the future direction of the Missouri Universal Service Fund. That notice conveyed Staff's request that such comments be filed no later than August 30. The Missouri Cable Telecommunications Association (MCTA) filed comments on September 3, the next business day after August 30. Along with its comments, MCTA filed a motion asking leave to file its comments one day out of time. The Commission will grant that request.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The Missouri Cable Telecommunications Association's Motion for Leave to File One Day Out of Time is granted.
