ORDER APPROVING INTERIM RATES EFFECTIVE MARCH 21, 1995

On March 9, 1995, Missouri Public Service (Company) of Kansas City, Missouri, filed with this Commission for approval, tariff sheets designed to reflect changes in its Northern and Southern Systems' Purchased Gas Adjustment (PGA) rates. The changes to the Southern System result from changes in Company's cost of gas, modified Refund and Take-Or-Pay factors, and a new Transition Costs Factor. The changes to the Northern System result from changes in the Company's cost of gas and a modified Refund factor.

The Missouri Public Service Commission Staff (Staff) stated it had reviewed the proposed filing and has determined that the filing was in compliance with the provisions of MPS's current PGA Clause. Staff recommended that the tariff sheets be approved interim subject to refund pending a final Commission determination in Case No. GR-94-331, Company's 1993-1994 ACA filing.

After considering Staff's recommendation and for good cause shown pursuant to Section 393.140(11) RSMo 1986, the Commission is of the opinion that the proposed tariff sheets should be approved to become effective on and after the requested effective date, March 21, 1995, interim subject to refund.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That the following tariff sheets submitted March 9, 1995, by Missouri Public Service of Kansas City, Missouri, for the purpose of reflecting changes in rates for natural gas and transportation service in the Company's Southern and Northern Systems, be and they are, hereby authorized to become effective on and after March 21, 1995, interim subject to refund.
