ORDER APPROVING NEELYVILLE DISTRICT RATES EFFECTIVE DECEMBER 1, 1994

On October 28, 1994, United Cities Gas Company (Company) of Brentwood, Tennessee, filed with this Commission for approval, a tariff sheet which reflects a decrease in the Purchased Gas Adjustment (PGA) factors for its Neelyville District resulting from a decrease in spot market gas costs. Additionally, the Avoided Commodity Cost for Transportation Customers will decrease.

Case No. GR-94-63, under which this tariff sheet was filed, was established to address Company's PGA factors that will be reviewed in its 1993-1994 Actual Cost Adjustment (ACA) filing.

The Missouri Public Service Commission Staff (Staff) has reviewed the filing and is of the opinion that the proposed changes comply with the current PGA Clause and recommends that the proposed tariff sheet be approved.

After reviewing Staff's recommendation, the Commission is of the opinion that the proposed tariff sheet should be allowed to become effective on and after the requested effective date of December 1, 1994.

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IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:


