ORDER GRANTING APPLICATION FOR REHEARING

Issue Date: October 27, 2021 Effective Date: October 27, 2021

On October 14, 2021, the Commission issued its Order Granting Variances, Granting Waiver, and Granting Expedited Treatment, which granted the joint application of Missouri-American Water Company (MAWC) and DCM Land, LLC (DCM) for variances from provisions of MAWC's tariff regarding the extension of a water service main to the Cottleville Trails development. On October 22, 2021, the Office of the Public Counsel (OPC) filed an *Application for Rehearing*. The Commission shortened the time for responses and on October 26, 2021, DCM filed a response in opposition to the application for rehearing.

Section 386.500.1, RSMo, states that the Commission shall grant an application for rehearing if "in its judgment sufficient reason therefor be made to appear." In the judgment of the Commission, OPC's application provides sufficient reason for the Commission to rehear the application and reconsider its order granting variances. Therefore, the Commission will grant rehearing.

The Commission will direct the parties to meet via WebEx telephone and video conference for a procedural conference in order to propose a joint procedural schedule.

Additionally, in accordance with Section 536.083, RSMo, this matter will be assigned to a different Regulatory Law Judge for the rehearing.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The Application for Rehearing filed on October 22, 2021, by OPC is granted.

2. The parties shall appear at an electronic procedural conference to be held on November 10, 2021, at 10:00 a.m. The procedural conference will be held electronically with all parties participating by video or telephone. The link and access code to participate in the conference will be emailed to counsel for all parties.

3. This order shall become effective when issued.
