## ORDER DIRECTING STAFF TO FILE A RECOMMENDATION

Issue Date: May 7, 2008 Effective Date: May 7, 2008

On April 30, 2008, The Raytown Water Company filed an application for authority to issue Water Facilities Refunding and Improvement Bonds, Series 2008. The Company states that the proceeds from the proposed bond issuance are to be used: (a) to refund at a more favorable interest rate the remaining balance of the outstanding Series 1999 EIERA Bonds; (b) to construct a new water main in the Company's service territory in Raytown, Missouri; (c) to pay for new trucks and other related plant and equipment required to operate and maintain the water facilities; (d) to fund any debt service reserve fund that may be required, and (e) to pay the costs and expenses of the bond issuance.

The Commission will be aided by a recommendation from its Staff. Therefore, the Commission will direct its Staff to file a recommendation or a status report indicating when it will be able to file a recommendation.

## IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. The Staff of the Commission shall, no later than June 6, 2008, file either its recommendation or a status report indicating the date on which it intends to file its recommendation.

- 2. Any response to Staff's recommendation shall be filed no later than ten days after the filing of Staff's recommendation.
  - 3. This order shall become effective on May 7, 2008.
