PROPOSED FILING DATE

COMES NOW, the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission (“Staff”), by and through counsel, and for its *Proposed Filing Date*, states as follows:

1. On September 1, 2021, the Missouri Public Service Commission (“Commission”) issued its *Order Directing Filing*, in which it directed the Staff of the Commission to file a pleading specifying the date certain it will file its recommendation regarding Missouri-American Water Company’s (“MAWC”) *Application and Motion for Waiver* (“*Application*”) in the above styled case.

2. Staff states that, at this time, it expects to file its recommendation regarding MAWC’s *Application* no later than October 28, 2021. This date will allow Staff to review responses to data requests it has already issued to MAWC, issue any follow-up data requests if necessary, and prepare its recommendation. Should Staff complete its review prior to October 28, 2021, it will submit its recommendation as soon as it is able.

WHEREFORE, Staff respectfully requests that the Commission issue an order directing its Staff to file a recommendation regarding MAWC’s *Application* no later than October 28, 2021; and such other and further relief as the Commission deems just in these circumstances.
