ORDER APPROVING REVISED DEPRECIATION RATES AND CLOSING CASE

On April 1, 1997, the Commission issued an order approving tariff changes and rate increases in this case. Within that order the Commission approved the water and sewer rates as recommended by Staff in Staff's memorandum which was filed in this case on April 2, 1997. On April 10 Staff filed another memorandum in this case which requested further action of the Commission.

In the April 10 memorandum Staff states that it had inadvertently omitted a reference to the depreciation rates which were used to calculate the applicant's agreed-upon revenue increase. To remedy the oversight, Staff attached a schedule that sets out the depreciation rates the Staff used in calculating the revenue requirement. Staff recommends that the Commission approve the depreciation rates as attached to the April 10 memorandum.

The Commission has reviewed the memorandum filed by Staff along with the entire file and concludes that approval of the revised depreciation rates will not change the rates currently charged to Riverside's customers. Rather, approval of these depreciation rates is consistent with the water rates previously approved by the Commission on

April 1. Therefore, the Commission will approve the revised depreciation rates as provided within the Staff's memorandum and as attached herewith as Attachment 1.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

- 1. That the water depreciation rates filed by the Staff on April 10 are approved for use by Riverside Utility Company.
 - 2. That Case No. WR-97-185 is closed.
- 3. That this order shall become effective on September 17, 1997.
