ORDER CANCELING CERTIFICATE AND TARIFF

The Staff of the Commission (Staff) filed a motion on June 11, 1997, asking the Commission to cancel the interexchange certificate and tariff of WATS/800, Inc. (WATS) for failure to comply with Missouri law and Commission orders. Staff stated that WATS had failed to file annual reports as required by statute, had been administratively dissolved by the Missouri Secretary of State, and had not kept the Commission apprised of its current address.

The Commission issued an Order Establishing Case and Giving Notice on August 5, 1997 directing that WATS be given notice of Staff's motion and an opportunity to be heard. WATS was directed to respond within 30 days to avoid cancellation of its certificate and tariff without further hearing. WATS filed no response.

The Commission has reviewed Staff's motion and recommendation, and the official file and finds that the interexchange certificate and tariff granted to WATS/800, Inc. in Case No. TA-92-26 shall be cancelled for failure to comply with Missouri statutes and the conditions of certification.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That the interexchange certificate and tariff granted to WATS/800, Inc. in Case No. TA-92-26 are cancelled.
2. That this order shall become effective on September 26, 1997.
