ORDER APPROVING BOWLING GREEN DISTRICT RATES EFFECTIVE NOVEMBER 1, 1994

On September 27, 1994, United Cities Gas Company (Company) of Brentwood, Tennessee, filed with this Commission for approval, a tariff sheet which reflects changes in the Purchased Gas Adjustment (PGA) factors for its Bowling Green District resulting from a decrease in spot market gas costs and a decrease in the cost of Panhandle Eastern Pipe Line Company's in/out storage capacity charge. Additionally, the Avoided Commodity Cost for Transportation Customers will decrease.

Case No. GR-94-63, under which this tariff sheet was filed, was established to address Company's PGA factors that will be reviewed in its 1993-1994 Actual Cost Adjustment (ACA) filing.

The Missouri Public Service Commission Staff (Staff) has reviewed the filing and is of the opinion that the proposed changes comply with the current PGA Clause and recommends that the proposed tariff sheet be approved.

After reviewing Staff's recommendation, the Commission is of the opinion that the proposed tariff sheet should be allowed to become effective on and after the requested effective date of November 1, 1994.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That the following tariff sheet filed September 27, 1994 by United Cities Gas Company of Brentwood, Tennessee, for the purpose of reflecting changes in the PGA factors for its Bowling Green District as a result of decreased spot market gas costs and a decrease in the cost of Panhandle Eastern Pipe Line Company's in/out storage capacity charge, be, and the same is, hereby authorized to become effective on and after November 1, 1994.
