The Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission (Staff) requests that the Secretary of the Missouri Public Service Commission pursuant to Section 386.440 RSMo and 4 CSR 240-2.100 issue a subpoena for the attendance of, **David McDonald** at an evidentiary hearing beginning on **January 25, 2011 at 2:00 p.m.** and continuing thereafter until excused, at **200 Madison Street, Jefferson City MO** 65102, in the Hearing Room 310. In PSC Cases ER-2010-0355 and ER-2010-0356, Kansas City Power & Light Company, Inc, and KCP&L Greater Missouri Operation's have requested a rate increase.

Under Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.100(2), a subpoena for appearance as a witness in an evidentiary hearing "shall not be issued fewer than twenty (20) days before hearing" except for a showing of good cause. Staff served a subpoena decus tecum on David McDonald for a Monday January 23, 2011. Staff believes it will likely discover information within that deposition which Staff will want to use during the evidentiary hearing scheduled for January 18 – February 4, 2011. The issues related to the Iatan 1, Iatan 2 and Iatan Common Plant Construction Projects are set for January 18 – 25, 2011. Due to the schedule of the hearing, Staff believes it is necessary to serve this subpoena on Mr. McDonald to ensure his availability during the evidentiary hearing.

Staff believes that new information likely to be obtained during the January 12, 2011 deposition warrants good cause to serve the subpoena on less than the 20 days requirement.
